

Teacher Participating Evaluation

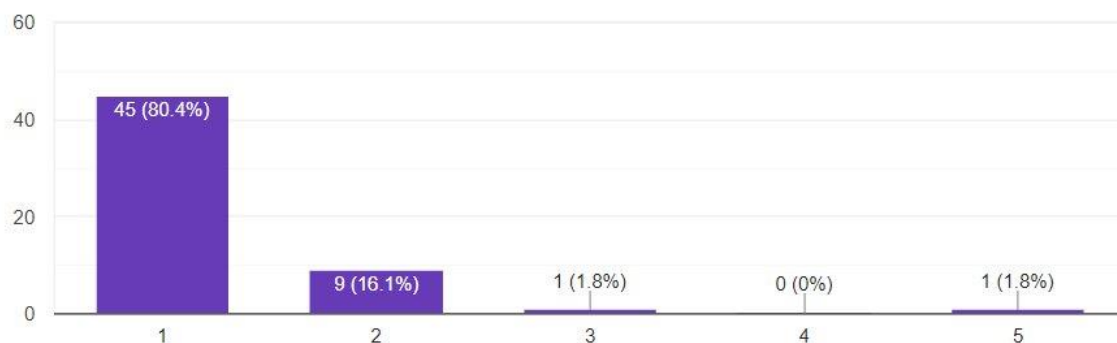

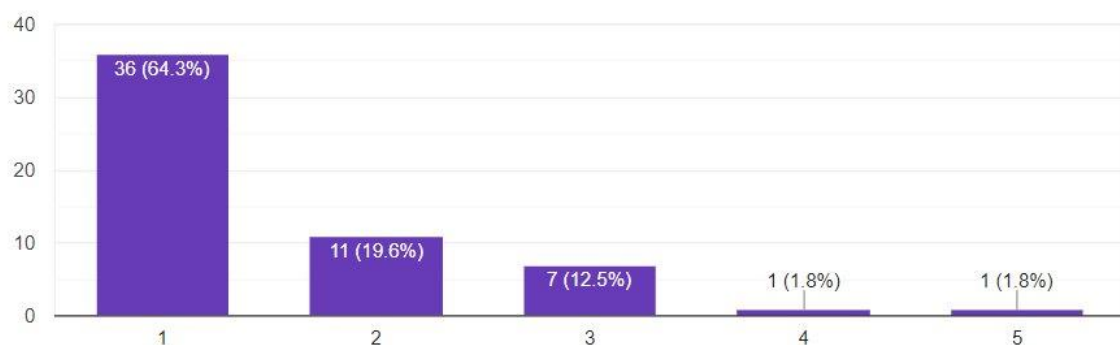


2-My language skills have improved during the project

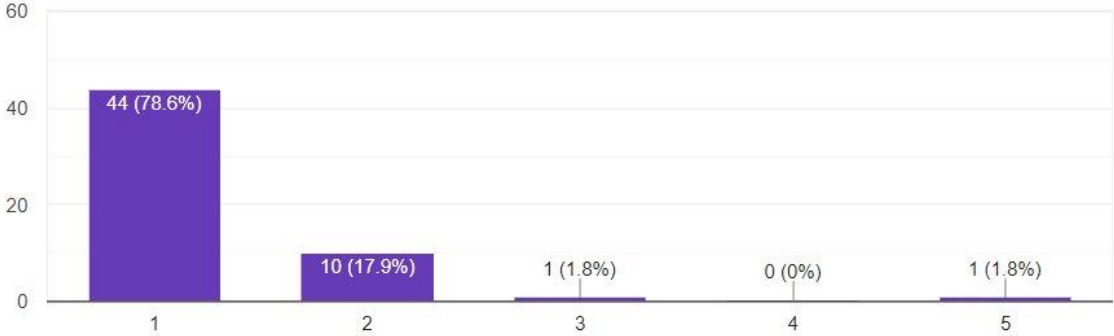


3-I have learnt new facts about the country I visited.

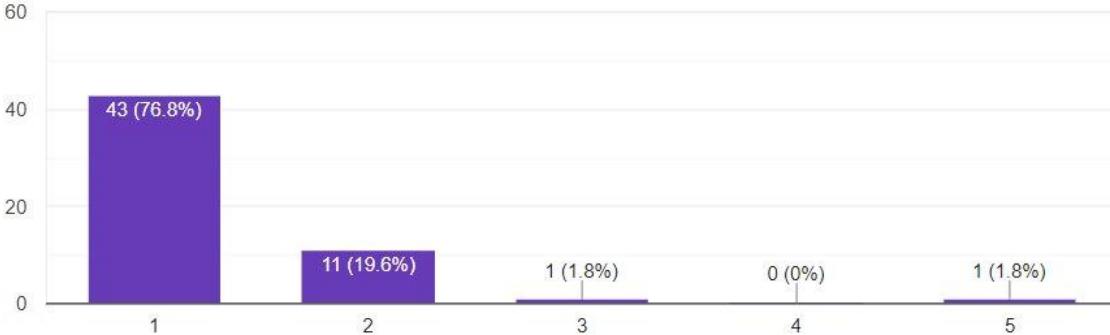


4-I have learnt new legends about the country I visited

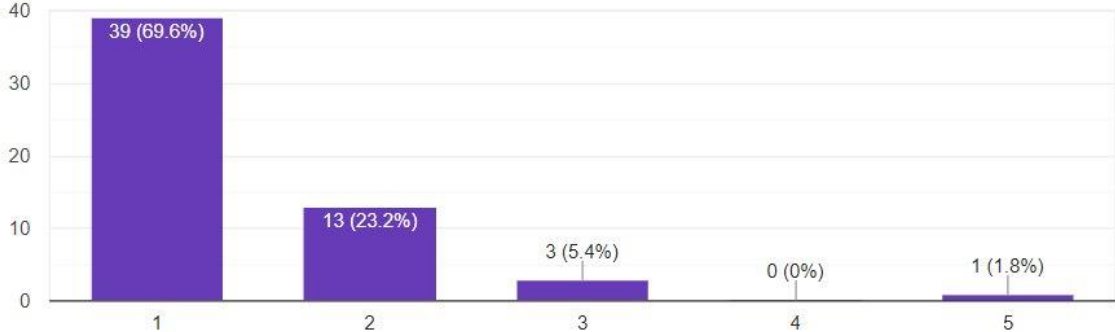


5- My ICT skills have improved.

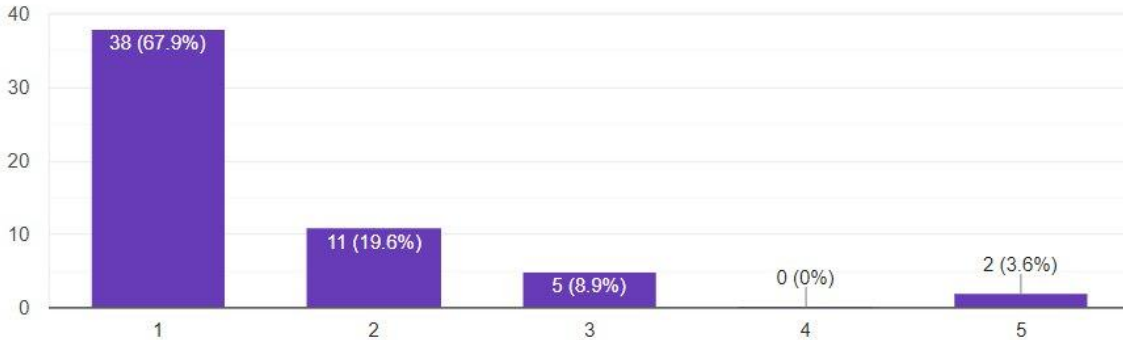


6-My teaching skills have improved.
