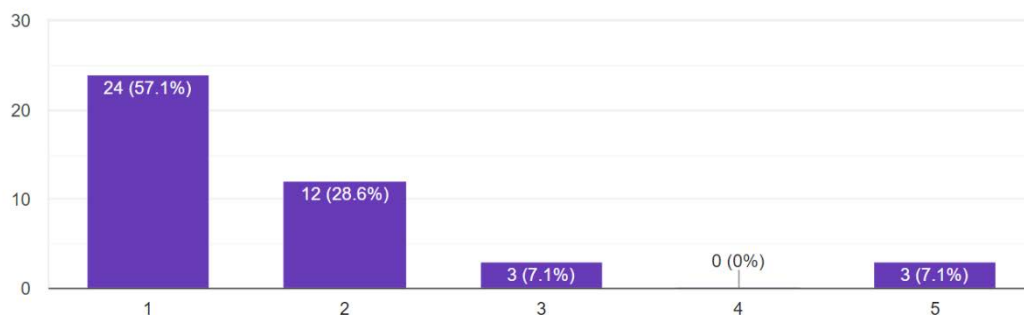


## Families Participation Evaluation

The satisfaction of the families participating in the project was evaluated according to a linear scale and it was determined as 1: I Strongly agree 5: I strongly disagree. The evaluation is taken into consideration as: 1 and 2 agree, 4 and 5 disagree.

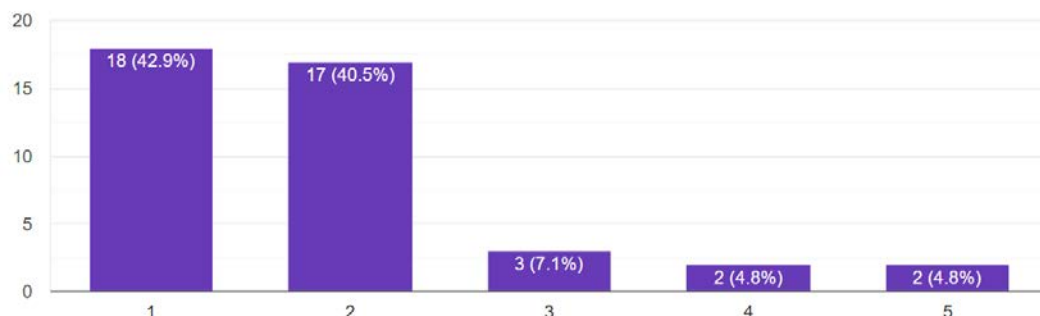
1- Being a host family in the project has been a good experience.

80.4% of the families who participated in the project stated that our project was a good experience as 57.1% strongly agree with the statement and 28.6% agree. Only 7.1% of the families think that their participation in the project hasn't been a good experience.



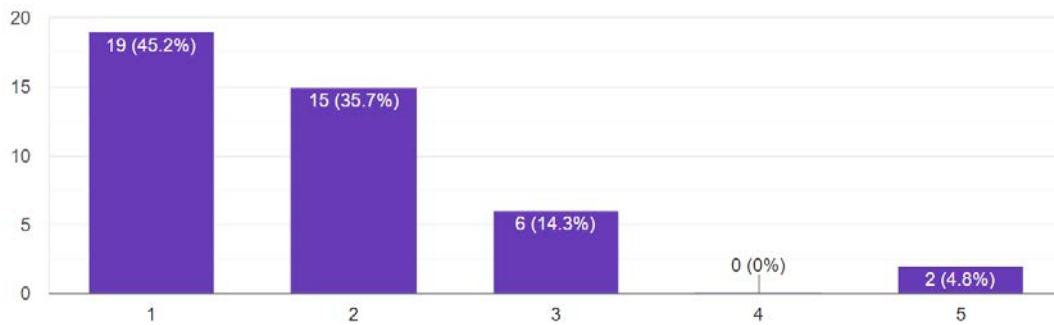
2. We found it easy to communicate with guest students.

42.9% of the families strongly agree with the statement. A similar percentage of them agrees with the statement, so in total more than 80 percent of the families found it easy to communicate with the students they hosted.



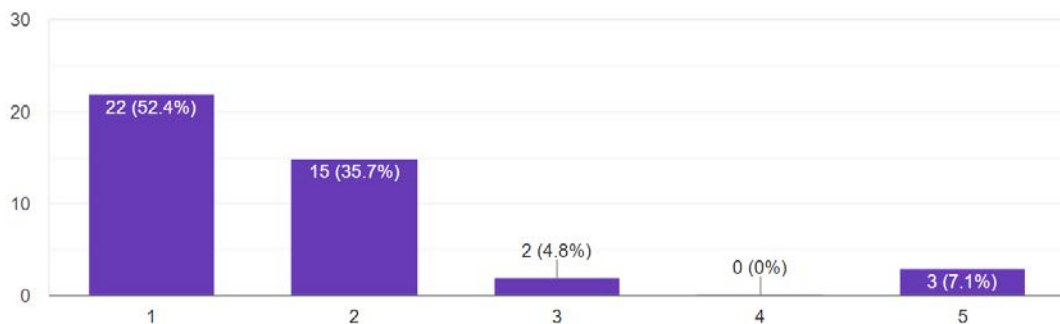
3. We have learnt new facts about the culture of the guest students.

45.2% of the families strongly agree with the statement and 35.7% agree and say that they have learnt new facts about the culture of the guest students. Only 4.8 per cent of the families said that they haven't learnt new facts about the culture of the guest students.



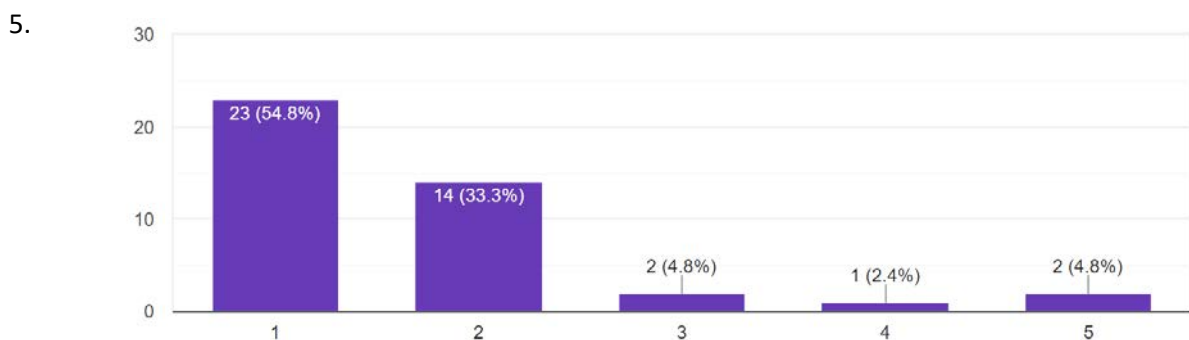
4. We think that the guest students have been successfully integrated into our family.

52.4% of the families strongly agree, and 35.7% agree with the statement. More than 80 per cent think that the integration of the guest students has been successful. 7.1 per cent of the families weren't satisfied with the integration of the foreign students.



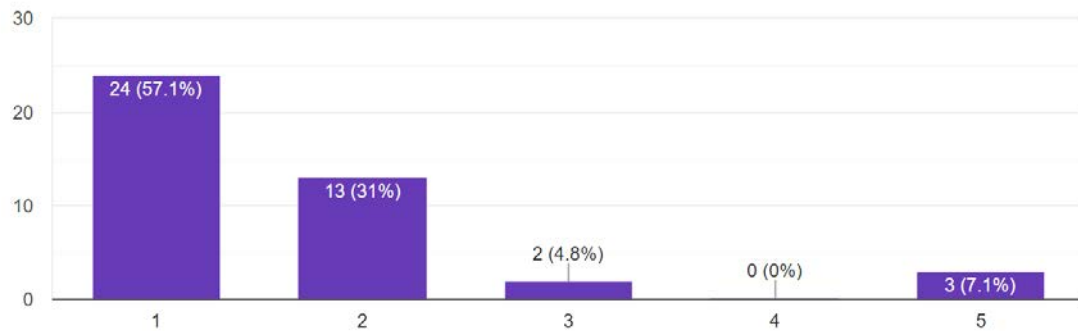
5. We think that our child has been successfully integrated in the project.

54.8% of the families strongly agree with the statement that their children have been successfully integrated in the project. 33% of the families agree. 4.8 per cent of the families think that their children weren't successfully integrated in the project.



6. We would like to be a host family again in another Erasmus project.

57.1% of the families strongly agree and 31% agree with the statement. So almost a 90 per cent of the families would like to be a host family again in another Erasmus project and only a 7 per cent said that they wouldn't repeat the experience.



Conclusion: more than 85% of the families are totally satisfied with their experiences during the project and stated that the project provided them with knowledge about other countries and that the integration of the foreign students and of their own children have been successful. Most of them would repeat the experience and would participate in an Erasmus project again.
